Waiting List Application

It is advisable to enroll your child on our waiting list as early as possible. Enrolments are accepted any time after your child is born.

Once a Waiting List Form is completed and the \$10 (non-refundable) fee is paid, names are entered on the waiting list register in date order. Enrolments are taken strictly in order of entry from the Waiting List Register. We do not have a sibling policy. Please note that the completion of a Waiting List Form does NOT secure a place for your child. This form is a waiting list application only. If you child is offered a place, we will ask you to complete an enrolment booklet to formalise the enrolment for your child.

Please advise the kindergarten should any of your contact details change to keep our records up to date.

About our Program

At Bayview Heights Community Kindergarten we place great emphasis on creating a warm and caring environment incorporating an atmosphere of respect to allow the child's first educational experience outside the home to be positive and fulfilling.

We believe that play is an essential element of the learning process in young children. Therefore, we believe that the value is in doing rather than in the end project.

In 2016 our Kindergarten has gone through an assessment process with Nature Play QLD and has been approved as a "Nature Play Education Provider". We view children's play in nature as critical to their healthy development.

Our program is based on recognition and understanding of the developmental needs of 3½ and 4½ year old children and the interests and abilities of individual children.

We value the input of all parents and members of the community into both our educational program and the management of the kindergarten.

The kindergarten operates with 2 groups of 22 pre-prep children.

When completing a waiting list application form, parents are asked to nominate which of the groups they would prefer. We will attempt to comply with your preferences.

Families of children offered a place at the kindergarten will be contacted from May onwards in the year before their child is due to attend. If you will be away during that time, please inform the kindergarten as your position will be forfeited unless acceptance is received within one week of notification.

Our kindergarten terms are based on the Queensland school terms.

Current Fees – 2022 (as at 1 Jan 2022)
2 Long Days program - \$55.3225 per day*
5-Day Fortnight program - \$44.258 per day*

***SEIFA subsidy** for eligible aged children
2 Long Days program - \$43.75 per day
5-Day Fortnight program - \$35 per day
(Eligible aged children must be at least 4 by 30 June in the year they are enrolled).

QKFS Plus Kindy support for eligible aged children with a health care card / pensioner card, triplets, or identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander:
2 Long Days program - \$12.6475 per day
5-Day Fortnight program - \$10.118 per day

Fees and levies are set by the committee and are subject to change each year.

Building Fund Levy

All families will be charged this annual \$50 levy (per child) in first term. This levy is allocated to the kindergarten's endorsed building fund to be used exclusively for repairs and maintenance of the kindy buildings.

Resource Levy

All families will be charged this annual \$40 levy (per child) in first term. This levy covers the cost of your child's portfolio, kindy sheet and Storypark access.

Maintenance Levy

\$50.00 per term (committee members are exempt from paying this levy). This is to cover the cost of hiring a grounds man and handyman to ensure our grounds and facilities are always well maintained.

Non-Participation Levy

The kindergarten requires the involvement of all families for at least two events (fundraising or working bee), or a \$100 non-participation levy will be charged.
