Bayview Heights Community Kindergarten Association is committed to supporting the health and wellbeing of everyone sharing our early childhood environment and ensuring children have a positive early education and care experience.

To help keep everyone safe, we ask that you follow these commitments.



Families will

- Not administer fever reducing medication to their child prior to arrival at the Centre
- Have one parent per child at drop off and pick up
- Limit drop off and pick up to a maximum of 15 minutes
- Wash theirs and their child's hands upon arrival and departure
- Use hand sanitiser or wash hands before and after using iCheck-in iPad (if applicable)
- Practise social distancing when at the Centre
- Promptly collect their child if they become unwell at the Centre
- Notify the Centre if they or their child are being tested for COVID-19 and advise us of the results

Everyone is restricted from entering or attending the Centre if they

- Are unwell
- Have had an ongoing fever over 38 degrees in the past 24 hours
- Have a cough or breathing difficulties (except those with a known respiratory condition)
- Have a sore throat
- Have returned from overseas and interstate travel within the last 14 days
- Have been directed by a Doctor or Queensland Public Health to self-isolate
- Have been in contact with a person who has been a confirmed case of COVID-19
- Are waiting for COVID-19 test results
