Wait List Application

It is advisable to enroll your child on our wait list as early as possible. Enrolments are accepted any time after your child is born.

Once a Wait List form is completed and returned, names are entered on the Wait List Register in date order. Enrolments are taken strictly in order of entry from the Wait List Register. We do not have a sibling policy. Please note that the completion of a Wait List form does NOT secure a place for your child. This form is a wait list application only. If your child is offered a place, we will ask you to complete an enrolment form to formalise the enrolment for your child.

Please advise the kindergarten should any of your contact details change to keep our records up to date.

About our Program

At Bayview Heights Community Kindergarten we place great emphasis on creating a warm and caring environment incorporating an atmosphere of respect to allow the child's first educational experience outside the home to be positive and fulfilling.

We believe that play is an essential element of the learning process in young children. Therefore, we believe that the value is in doing rather than in the end project.

The kindergarten operates with 2 groups of 22 pre-prep children.

When completing a Wait List Application form, parents are asked to nominate which of the groups they would prefer. We will attempt to accommodate your preference.

Families of children offered a place at the kindergarten will be contacted from May onwards in the year before their child is due to attend. If you will be away during that time, please inform the kindergarten as your position will be forfeited unless acceptance is received within one week of notification.

Our kindergarten terms are based on the Queensland school terms.

Current Fees – 2025 (as of 1st January 2025)

Kindy will be fee free for children who are aged at least 4 years by 30 June in the year before they start Prep.

Free kindy is for a 15 hour per week, 40 weeks per year, government-approved education program.

Free KiNDY

Non-eligible aged child

If your child is enrolled and claiming the Queensland Kindergarten Funding (QKF) at another kindergarten program (in a Childcare or Kindergarten service), you will not be able to claim free kindy at this centre and a Daily Rate will be charged. This will also impact the centre claiming additional subsidies therefore your child's daily rate will be increased to cover the loss of this funding.

Daily Rate

2 Long Days program - \$74 per day*
